The belief that each soul has a personal guardian angel has long been accepted by the Catholic Church. They are given to us by God to provide, console and protect. For instance, St. Raphael's role in the Old Testament story of Tobias shows us how God entrusts to the angels the protection and care of His little ones.

In a very real sense, Kay Wessel is much like a guardian angel.

In 2010, Kay's husband, Jerry, was delivering trailers at various parishes to collect used furniture for Catholic Social Services (CSS). Her pastor at the time told her there was a great need for diapers all across the diocese. Kay was inspired with the idea of holding a

That first drive in 2010 yielded approximately 49,000 diapers. The 2022 drive brought in 166,000 diapers. All told, in the 13 years of the LDCCW Diaper Drive. 1.3 million diapers have been collected. CSS and other organizations and pregnancy centers across the diocese in such

towns as North Platte, McCook, and Superior then distribute the diapers. Other items such as wipes are also collected and given away. Monetary donations also come in through the drive and throughout the year. Kay uses the funds to purchase diapers in bulk, and as Kay put it, the Fed-Ex man knows her well. She even said to him, "I bet you wonder what I'm doing with all of these diapers. I give them all away!"
