"It saved my life being here"

St. Gianna Program resident thankful for the support that carried her from a life of abuse to a future filled with hope "I got to the point where I thought it was normal."

Stephanie now knows what she experienced before coming to our St. Gianna Program last summer was not "normal." There is nothing normal about being told you are not worth anything, or getting your leg run over by a truck or having multiple black eyes and cracked ribs. This was the life that Stephanie until recently.

Stephanie went into rehab four years ago, but was still living in an unhealthy relationship. The abuse was sporadic at first, which led Stephanie to think "this won't last" and "It's probably something I've done. It will get better." It didn't. The abuse became constant and she couldn't take it any longer. "I got sick of it. It was not ending." Her sponsor in AA had heard about our St. Gianna Program and helped Stephanie reach out for help through Catholic Social Services. Within two weeks, Stephanie came to our St. Gianna Program with "my sobriety, my clothes and a few things that were on my wall that were my grandmother's." Now, her life is so different than it was just a few short months ago.

Stephanie now feels a sense of peace and calm- a welcome change from the environment she came from. She has a full-time job and is saving up to buy a car. Her goal is to be self-sufficient to the point where she can move to her own apartment early next year. Stephanie is so grateful for the love and support she receives in the family-atmosphere of our St. Gianna Program. "The Marian Sisters have been wonderful! When you walk in the door and are greeted by their smiles, it's the best feeling ever!" Most of all, she is so grateful for the life she now leads. "There is help out there. It saved my life being here."
