In Giving that we Receive

"For it is in giving that we receive; it is in pardoning that we are pardoned; and it is in dying that we are born to eternal life." These words from St. Francis of Assisi offer insight into what it takes to live a truly fulfilled life.

St. Francis was born into a wealthy family and spent his early years in comfort, popularity, teenage rebellion, and frivolous parties. He went to war at 19, seeking the glorious life of a knight. Instead, Francis was defeated in battle, imprisoned, and held for ransom. Alone in captivity and weakened by illness, he turned to prayer, reflecting deeply on the path his life had taken. Upon his release, Francis returned to Assisi where he felt an intense call to live differently. He began receiving visions from God, urging him to "rebuild the Church." He spent more time with the sick, the poor, and the outcast, discovering the profound freedom in giving himself fully to God and others. He renounced his family's wealth and embraced a life of poverty and dependence on God.

Francis was assured a future of wealth, power, and security, but chose the path of humility, poverty, and vulnerability. He found that a self-serving life is empty compared to the




joy of serving those in need.




